

ABOUT THE PROGRAM

Dolly Parton's Imagination Library is a book gifting program that mails free, age-appropriate, high-quality books to children from birth until they begin school, no matter their family's income.



WHY IT MATTERS

- Children who are not reading at grade level by 3rd grade are four times more likely to drop out of school.
- 80% of low-income students are not reading at grade level by 4th grade.

SUCCESS TO DATE

Launched in November of 2015 with the generous support of community funders like you, The Dolly Parton's Imagination Library Team has been able to:

- Mail more than 85,000 books to Linn County Children to date.
- Register over 4,100 local children county-wide, including more than 2,600 children actively enrolled now.

AND – Early studies show this investment is working. According to 2018-2019 Greater Albany Public Schools Kindergarten Readiness Scores, participants enrolled in DPIL for 18 months or more increased:
