

LINN COUNTY

46% of residents live in poverty or ALICE.1,787 children were referred for child abuse cases.58% of 3rd graders aren't meeting reading standards.

BENTON COUNTY

45% of residents live in poverty or ALICE.

698 children were referred for child abuse cases.

47% of 3rd graders aren't meeting reading standards.

LINCOLN COUNTY

42% of residents live in poverty or ALICE.


613 children were referred for child abuse cases.

65% of 3rd graders aren't meeting reading standards.

Meet ALICE: For a growing number of U.S. households, finanicial stability is out of reach, no matter how hard their members work. These households are ALICE. ALICE stands for Asset Limited, Income Constrained, Employed - earning above the Federal Poverty Level, yet struggling to afford basic necessitites.
